

**AMERICAN DWARF HOTOT RABBIT BREEDERS ASSOCIATION
MASTER BREEDER APPLICATION**

To become a master breeder, you must show consistent achievement as a breeder over a 3-year period. Master breeder applications must be submitted with proof of successfully completing at least 2 out of the 5 qualifications listed below each year for 3 consecutive years:

- Receive a BOB or BOS at a national show (there must be at least 5 dwarf hotots shown by 3 exhibitors to qualify)
- Receive a BIS or RIS award at any ARBA sanctioned ALL-BREED show
- Finish in the Top 5 in National Sweepstakes competition.
- Place at least one rabbit in the top 5 at an ADHRC national or ARBA convention show with a minimum of 10 animals in the class.
- Awarded Best Display at ADHRC National or ARBA Convention

Rules:

- Member(s) MUST show under the same name(s) during the 3 consecutive years of achievement
- Youth members can carry-over achievements into open if they transition to an open member within the 3-year time frame
- Member must serve ADHRC as a board member, committee chair, appointed convention chair or host of a national show each of the 3 years
- Member must be an ADHRC member for a minimum of 5 consecutive years at time of application
- ADHRC members awarded "Charter Breeder" status will be recognized in the Dwarf Hotot News and provided an award/memento (TBD) by ADHRC.
