AMERICAN DWARF HOTOT RABBIT CLUB HALL OF FAME

The Hall of Fame is designed to recognize the accomplishments of specific animals in the dwarf hotot breed. This honor promotes sustainability and structural correctness in breeding, as it is only awarded to animals who have proven their winningness over time and multiple shows and events. Animals accepted into the hall of fame will have pictures retained for historical purposes as well.

The breeder will be provided with a certificate of achievement and the rabbit will be featured with photo and write-up in the Dwarf Hotot News.

Rabbits can be nominated by owner, breeder or any ADHRC member. Rabbits that are now deceased can still be nominated provided proof of qualification can be submitted. There is no limit to the number of animals that can be admitted into the Hall of Fame per year, and there will not be animals that qualify every year. The owner of the animal must be an ADHRC member to qualify. If animal is co-owned, both owners must be ADHRC members. The animal must be purebred and a 3-generation pedigree OR ARBA registration number is to be submitted with the application.

A Dwarf Hotot can be nominated for the ADHRC Hall of Fame if they meet at least 2 of the 5 criteria listed below:

-Received BOB or BOS at an ADHRC National Show, National Specialty Show or ARBA Convention provided at least 5 dwarf hotots are shown by 3 exhibitors -Received a BIS or RIS at an ARBA sanctioned all-breed show

-Has won their class (1st place) at 2 ADHRC National shows, 2 ARBA Conventions or one of each -Has placed in the top five at the ADHRC National Show and/or ARBA Convention 3 or more times -Has earned a total of 15 grand champion ARBA legs or more in the duration of their lifetime
