

The Trudy Milburn Youth Contest

The award is named in honor of the contributions and mentorship to the rabbit hobby by mentor Trudy Milburn. The purpose of this contest is to honor Trudy Milburn for everything that she has done to help young people with all of their endeavors, and the impact that she left on them.

There will be two cash awards of \$100 each, one to a **Senior** age division winner and one to a **Junior** age division winner, provided there are qualified mini-newsletter submissions. The cash award is to be used according to the needs of the recipients' hobby, such as but not limited to, feed, supplies, show entries, attending National ARBA Convention, attending Dwarf Hotot Nationals, or to purchase stock. Funds for this contest are provided by a donation.

The mini-newsletter should be submitted to the chair of the Scholarship Committee no later than September 15th for consideration of award at the following ARBA Convention.

Guidelines:

The youth applying for the grant must meet the following qualifications:

- A. Age: **Junior** division 8- 12 years of age by September 15th of the application year; **Senior** division 13 years of age and not older than 18 by September 15th of the application year.
- B. Maintain membership in ADHRC for at least 2 years.
- C. Submit a mini-newsletter for consideration.

The mini-newsletter should consist of following guidelines all relating to Dwarf Hotots:

- A. Up to five pages, including a cover page
- B. Photography.
- C. Creative writing: to include at least one article regarding raising, showing, or breeding Dwarf Hotots.
- D. Creativity.
