

Nancy Nyberg Memorial Grant

The purpose of this grant is to honor Nancy Nyberg for her involvement and commitment to youth in raising and showing rabbits.

The grant is a voucher of \$100. awarded annually, provided there are qualified essay submissions. The voucher is to secure Dwarf Hotot stock to improve the breeding program of the recipient. The stock must be secured from a member of the ADHRC. The voucher can be redeemed by the breeder through the secretary/treasurer of the club. Funds for this grant will be provided by donations and/or auction proceeds.

The essay should be submitted to the chair of the Scholarship Committee no later than September 15th for consideration of award at the following ARBA Convention.

Guidelines:

The youth applying for the grant must meet the following qualifications:

- A. Age: 8 by September 15th of the application year and not older than 18 on that date.
- B. Maintain membership in ADHRC for at least 2 years.
- C. Submit an essay for consideration.

The essay should follow but is not limited to the following guidelines:

- A. Describe yourself including your grade, state of residence, length of time raising rabbits (especially Dwarf Hotots), showing experience, and local clubs you may belong to.
- B. How will the grant help you with your Dwarf Hotot breeding program?
- C. Where do you intend to secure the stock?
- D. What are you looking for in the animal to improve your breeding program? Why?
- E. Are you looking for a buck or doe? Why?
- F. Include anything else that would help determine your qualifications for this grant.
